Mobile devices:


Both Android and iOS mobile devices can be used to join a webinar. First download the free Citrix GoToWebinar app from your usual app store.

The control panel on the left contains a variety of tools for you to make the most of the session.

- On joining the call please ensure you have your microphone on mute Box (1) on the diagram will generally be coloured red if you are set to mute and green for unmuted.
- Any handouts mentioned by the speakers should be available on the event webpage or in box (3) on the control panel entitled Handouts.
- We greatly encourage questions and comments during the session, there are two ways to interact during the day:
 - Please use the Questions chat box (4) on the control panel to privately submit questions at any time, the chat box will be moderated and questions will be read out to speakers once they have completed there presentation (as much as time allows)
 - Alternatively if you would like to ask a question verbally or make a
 contribution to discussion, please click raise you virtual hand, this
 can be found on the control panel box (2), the moderator will
 unmute you in addition you will also have to unmute yourself by
 clicking on the microphone icon on the control panel box (1)

How to participate

• Audio problems:

If you hear an echo and are listening through your computer (VoIP), try reducing the volume of your speakers. If faint, try increasing the volume!

If you encounter further difficulties and are using VoIP, please mute your computer and join the audio conference by telephone. Click 'Telephone' in the 'Audio' box of the control panel and follow the instructions.

If you join by telephone, you may encounter feedback. Please mute your computer and continue listening by telephone. Please also ensure that you select 'Telephone' in the 'Audio' box and enter the audio pin.

• Other problems:

Please raise any other issues with the organiser (Vicky Drew) in the 'Questions' box. It is possible to leave and re-join the webinar for a better connection using the original joining e-mail.
