


What is Open Access?

- Making content openly available online to read
 - Meaning the article can be read by anyone, anywhere
- Making content reusable by third parties with little or no restrictions
 Meaning the research can be built upon









How is OA supported?

Submission – preprint/AOM

Acceptance – accepted manuscript (AM)

Publication – VoR/Publishers' PDF

Green – through subscriptions, so an embargo is applied

Gold – through Article publishing charge (APC) or subsidy

95% journals have a hybrid option

330 journals are fully OA

65 journals converted to OA 2020-2023

9 new OA journals launching in 2022




Workflow for an OA Article at T&F

Supporting expert independent evaluation (peer review)

- Financial and technical support
- Reviewer training and recognition
- Ethics checks



SUBMISSION

Systems and technical support

- Platform, submission and peer review system management
- Content enrichment (standards, metadata)
- Technical manuscript checks, anonymization, and management of independent, expert review





Payment routes for OA




